## **Fall Picture Day**

Fall Picture Day will be Thursday, October 6th. Picture Day forms will be sent home with students the last week of September. If you have any questions, please contact the elementary office.

Masks REQUIRED. As a part of our return to in-person instruction, all students in Kindergarten through 12th grade will be required to wear a mask while in the school building. We are also asking all preschool students to wear a mask upon entrance and dismissing from school. This is a requirement from the Department of Health, but it will also ensure that we are reducing the chances of transmission, thus increasing the chances of continuing with in-person schooling.

## **Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures**

As you will now notice, Adela Street along the curb by the school is now NO PARKING. This Adela curb lane will now be a drop off for Preschool through 2nd grade. The curb lane along Oak Street in front of the elementary office will also be a drop off lane, but for 3rd through 6th grade students only. If you are dropping off a student in PreK-2nd AND a students in 3rd-6th, you must wait in each drop off lane. Parents that choose to drop off their child in the car rider line will need to enter the drop off line that is marked by the cones.

Parents, please stay in your car and allow your child to exit the vehicle on the curb side only. Staff members will be on duty to assist your child out of the car and into the school building. If you would like to walk your child to the door of the school, you must park on a side street and then walk your child to the school entrance. Unfortunately during this time, no parent will be able to enter the school building beyond the elementary office.

At dismissal time, students will exit the building through the same doors they entered the building. Preschool through 2nd grade exit through the Adela doors and 3rd-6th grade will exit through the main doors on Oak Street.

## **School Day Schedule**

### AM STUDENTS

7:35-7:50 AM Students will enter the school building. Students in PreK-2nd will have breakfast waiting for them in the classroom. Students in 3rd-6th will grab a breakfast on the way to the classroom. All students will be temperature checked upon entrance into the building.

11:05 AM students will be dismissed from school through the same doors they entered. PreK-2nd through the Adela doors and 3rd-6th grade through the main elementary doors on Oak Street. All AM students will grab a lunch on the way out for dismissal

\*\*students will be dismissed in staggers, with younger students being dismissed a few minutes before older students

### PM STUDENTS

11:45-12:00 PM Students will enter the school building. Students in PreK-2nd will have lunch waiting for them in the classroom. Students in 3rd-6th will grab a lunch on the way to the classroom. All students will be temperature checked upon entrance into the building.

3:15 PM students will be dismissed from the school through the same doors they entered. PreK-2nd through the Adela doors and 3rd-6th grade through the main elementary doors on Oak Street. All PM students will grab an afternoon snack and breakfast on the way out for dismissal.

\*\*students will be dismissed in staggers, with younger students being dismissed a few minutes before older students.
