QUESTIONS TO ASK AT A COLLEGE FAIR

- Verify admission requirements. Will you need to take the optional ACT *Writing* Test?
- Find out how to apply. Essay? Letters of recommendation?
- Request a view book and other publications.
- Determine the college's tuition and fees.
- Ask about financial aid opportunities, including scholarships, as well as deadlines and forms required.
- Ask how to meet with faculty in the department of your intended major.
- Ask questions about academic requirements/offerings.
- Ask how to attend a class to get an idea of typical size, teaching style, and academic atmosphere.
- Ask about the placement record for graduates in the field you might study.
- Identify career planning services for undergraduates.
- Ask how to tour the campus and check out residence halls, dining options, and library resources.
- Find out what student activities (clubs, organizations, intramurals, etc.) are available and about campus life and social activities.
- Investigate transportation options.
- Investigate resources for students with special needs or who may require tutoring services.
- Ask them what makes their school stand out among colleges.
