Dear Ludlow Families,

As directed today by Governor Andy Beshear, our schools are not permitted to hold in-person instruction November 23, 2020 through January 4, 2021. We will need to move to our fully Remote Learning Plan for all students during this time.

Some items and reminders for families:

- Our Remote Learning Plan will be implemented November 30 through December 18. We will not hold classes, even virtually, on Monday and Tuesday, November 23 and 24, as our calendar originally indicated. Students will be off the entire week of Thanksgiving, November 23-27.
- In Governor Beshear's order, elementary schools can reopen to in-person learning on December 7 IF the county is not in red. We will monitor our county's status as December 7 draws closer, and will possibly offer in-person learning for the elementary students if we are able to. The order stated that all middle school and high schools (our Grades 7-12) must stay virtual through January 4.
- All students/families should follow their typical schedule tomorrow and Friday this week. Our campus will be open tomorrow for those who are on the on-campus plan.
- Elementary students who don't always take home their chromebooks will all take them home tomorrow so that they have them for our extended weeks of Remote Learning.
- Please contact us if you have internet issues. We can assist you with this so that your child doesn't miss critical learning time during our extended period of Remote Learning. Contact Cathy Pedro at cathy.pedro@ludlow.kyschools.us or 859-261-3223.
- Teachers will communicate with their specific students/classes regarding their schedules and online expectations. This varies by teacher, by grade, and by content. If you ever have questions or concerns, we encourage you to reach out to your child's teacher.
- Grab & Go Meals will continue this week as usual. ****Special Reminder: Turkey Dinner Day is this Friday!**** Meals will not be served November 23-27.
